Avon Lodge





Accommodation details

Type of accommodation

Self-catering accommodation consisting of 5 single rooms with shared bathroom and 1 single ensuite room. 5 of the rooms can be twin accommodation for couples, friends or family who are travelling together. Please check for availability.

Kitchen

Large, beautifully-decorated and fully-furnished kitchen, with modern appliances, spacious dining area and access to large outdoor patio.

Rooms

5 spacious single rooms with either single bed or twin beds (for two people sharing), large closet space, desk, chair and lamp.

Bathrooms

The residence has shared bathrooms. There is one large modern bathroom with large bath and free standing modern shower on the first floor and a modern free standing shower room on the second floor. The en-suite bedroom has its own shower room.

Laundry

There is a washing machine available for students' use in the kitchen.

Utilities

Electricity, gas and water are included in the accommodation fee. Electrical current is 240 volts AC (50 cycles) and students from some countries may require a transformer and a plug adaptor.

Internet and phone

Broadband Internet access is included in the price.

Security and keys

Students are provided with a key on arrival. Loss of keys will incur a £40 replacement fine.

Linen and towels

Bed linen will be provided to students upon arrival. Students should bring their own towels.

Visitors

No unaccompanied visitors are allowed. Visitors must leave by 11pm and are not permitted to stay overnight.

Noise and restrictions

Students are requested to be considerate to their neighbours and keep noise levels, including playing music, to a minimum especially after 10 pm.

Deposit

A £200 damage deposit is to be paid to the owner on arrival. This will be refunded on departure subject to inspection of the room.

Availability

Available from 14th August 2011.

Arrival and departure

The owners live on site and students will be provided with the contact details. Students should call the owner to inform them of estimated time of arrival.

Check in is on Saturday or Sunday between 3pm-10.30pm. Check out is strictly on Saturday before 10am.
